**Ryan Clint Young**

Sergeant Ryan Clint Young was born on June 29, 1982 in Orange, California. Upon graduation from Norco High School in 2000, he enlisted in the United States Army as an Infantryman. After completing his training at Fort Benning, GA in December 2000, SGT Young received his first assignment to Fort Riley, Kansas. In January 2001 he was assigned to B Company, 1-16 Infantry, 1st Infantry Division as a rifleman. Two months later, in March, he was re-assigned to A Company as a grenadier. In August 2001, SGT Young volunteered to deploy in support of Operation Intrinsic Action in Kuwait, where he served for four months. As a result of his exceptional abilities and demonstrated leadership, he was promoted to the rank of Sergeant and given the position of Team Leader in only three years. In early September 2003, SGT Young deployed to Iraq with the 1st Brigade Combat Team, First Infantry Division in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. SGT Young sustained critical injuries while leading his team on patrol in Iraq on November 8, 2003. He was transferred to Walter Reed Medical Center, Washington D.C. where he was cared for until his passing on December 2, 2003.

SGT Young's awards include the Meritorious Service Medal, the Army Achievement Medal (2 OLC), the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, the National Defense Service Medal, and the Army Service Ribbon.

SGT Young is survived by his wife, Sarah, his parents, Kathi and Marvin, and two sisters, Jennifer and Nicole.
